

## Badge Positions on the Brassard Air Training Corps

**ALL BRASSARDS TO BE WORN OUTSIDE THE TURNUP ON SHIRTS WHEN ROLLED ABOVE ELBOW  
NEVER TO BE WORN WITH CS 95**

Classification Badges – First Class-Leading-Senior Cadet-Master Air Cadet are to be worn in a central position immediately below and touching the Distinguishing badge. Only one Classification Badge is to be worn and is to be for the highest classification for which the cadet is qualified.

Leadership Course badge – is to be worn in a central position immediately below and touching the Classification badge.

Nijmegen Badge – is to be worn on the left hand side of the brassard with the base of the badge 9 cm from the bottom edge, and 6 mm from the left hand edge of the brassard.

Marksman Badges – are to be worn on the bottom left hand side of the brassard 6 mm from the bottom edge and with the centre of the badge 6 cm from the centre line of the brassard. The Cadet 50 and 100 badge are to be worn in the same position but with the years flashes equally placed 6mm from the bottom and main badge immediately above and touching with the edge of the badge 6mm from the left hand curved edge of the brassard. Only one Marksman badge the highest level is to be worn.

Central position

Identification Badge – is to be worn centrally 6mm from the top edge of the brassard.

The Air Training Corps Badge is to be worn in a central position immediately below and touching the Identification badge.

Communication Badge – is to be worn with the base of the badge 9 cm from the bottom edge and the top right hand corner 6 mm from the right hand edge of the brassard.

Musicians Badges - are to be worn on the centre line of the brassard with the centre of the badge 6 cm from the bottom edge of the brassard.

First Aid Badge – is to be worn on the bottom right hand side and 6 mm from the bottom edge of the brassard, with the centre of the badge 6 cm from the centre line of the brassard. Only the highest award is to worn and only for the duration that the cadet is qualified.
